Meet characters Axi and Zi as they go on a journey of discovery. They travel through different worlds to find out about who they are.

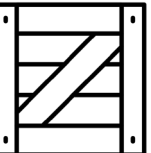
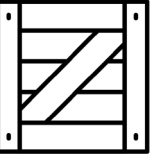
AFTERLIFE asks us to think about how journeys in games can help us imagine places we've never been.

Rachel makes artworks using different technologies, starring herself as different characters. For this exhibition, she has made a film called *They've Got Your Eyes*.

In the story you meet a character called 'The Gentleman' who invents a process for generating fairies using A.I. (Artificial Intelligence). The fairies have a superpower: they can bring to life anything the Gentleman asks for.

He soon discovers he has a rival... Another Gentleman.

The two men ask their fairies to create whatever they want, without considering what the fairies themselves might wish to create.

But the fairies start to have their own ideas and don't always listen to what the Gentlemen are telling them...
